ABOUT THE COURSE

The 4th Annual Mayo Clinic Thyroid and Parathyroid Disorders Course 2023 is a three-day CME course offering a comprehensive review of diagnostic techniques and medical and surgical management of thyroid and parathyroid disorders. Topics of discussion include the assessment of benign thyroid diseases as well as pre- and postoperative management of thyroid cancer and parathyroid disorders. Discussions include review of cutting-edge imaging modalities and diagnostic methods such as molecular testing for evaluation of thyroid nodules as well as therapeutic options for the management of benign and malignant thyroid and parathyroid conditions. This course consists of a combination of lectures and panel discussions about diagnostic and therapeutic options for management of challenging parathyroid and thyroid cases, as well as roundtable small group discussions with various experienced speakers.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

The course is designed for endocrinologists, endocrine surgeons, head and neck surgeons, primary care physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and other providers who care for patients with thyroid and parathyroid disorders, including residents and fellows.
